Sub: Application for Letter of permission for functioning of Dakshin Kesari Muni Mishrilalji Homoeopathic Medical College, Behind Bibi Ka Makbara, Shree Guru Ganesh Nagar, Aurangabad – 431004, for admission in BHMS course with intake capacity of 100 seats and M.D. (Hom.) course with intake capacity of 42 seats in 07 subjects namely Pharmacy (06 seats), Organon of Medicine (06 seats), Repertory (06 seats), Materia Medica (06 seats), Practice of Medicine (06 seats), Paediatrics (06 seats) and Psychiatry (06 seats) for academic year 2026-27 reg.

Sir/Madam,

Dakshin Kesari Muni Mishrilalji Homoeopathic Medical College, Behind Bibi Ka Makbara, Shree Guru Ganesh Nagar, Aurangabad – 431004 has submitted an application for permission of 100 seats in BHMS course and M.D. (Hom.) course with intake capacity of 42 seats in 07 subjects namely Pharmacy (06 seats), Organon of Medicine (06 seats), Repertory (06 seats), Materia Medica (06 seats), Practice of Medicine (06 seats), Paediatrics (06 seats) and Psychiatry (06 seats) for the academic year 2026-27. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARBH) has conducted inspection of the college on 05.05.2026 & 06.05.2026 followed by hearing on 06.06.2026. The Board has examined the College to ascertain whether the college fulfils the Minimum Essential Standards as per the regulations in force. On careful examination of the report, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board observed the following shortfalls:

A. College Functioning:

- a. **Teaching staff:** A total of fifty-seven teaching faculty members (56 + 1 Principal) are registered and marking their attendance on the AEBAS portal. In addition, three more faculty members are employed by the college and are available on the AEBAS portal—one extra faculty in the UG department of Surgery, one in the UG department of Obstetrics & Gynaecology and one in the PG department of Research Methodology & Biostatistics, however there are following department-wise deficiencies in the college:
 1. **UG staff:** There is a department-wise deficiency of three teaching faculty against the requirement of 40 + 1 teachers, which are required as per sub-regulations E(2) and E(3) of the First Schedule, and Regulations A and B of the Third Schedule of the National Commission for Homoeopathy (Minimum Essential Standards for Homoeopathic Colleges and Attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
 - i. **In Department of Pathology-** There is deficiency of one Associate Professor.
 - ii. **In Department of Surgery-** There is deficiency of one Associate Professor.
 - iii. **In Department of Gynaecology and Obstetrics-** There is deficiency of one Associate Professor.
 2. **PG staff:** There is a department-wise deficiency of nine teaching faculty against the required number, which are required as per sub-regulation (1) of Regulation 15 of the National Commission for Homoeopathy (Homoeopathy Post-Graduate

Degree Course – Doctor of Medicine in Homoeopathy) Amendment Regulations, 2025.

- i. **In Department of Organon of Medicine-** There is deficiency of one Associate Professor and one Assistant Professor.
- ii. **In Department of Pharmacy-** There is deficiency of one Associate Professor.
- iii. **In Department of Repertory-** There is deficiency of one Professor and one Associate Professor.
- iv. **In Department of Paediatrics-** There is deficiency of one Professor.
- v. **In Department of Psychiatry-** There is deficiency of one Associate Professor.
- vi. **In Department of Practice of Medicine-** There is deficiency of one Associate Professor.
- vii. **In Department of Research Methodology & Biostatistics-** There is deficiency of one Associate Professor.

The above deficiencies of teaching staff will inevitably compromise the standards of teaching, leading to profound learning crisis.

B. Hospital Functioning: Hospital functioning is not as per the Second Schedule of National Commission for Homoeopathy (Minimum Essential Standards for Homoeopathic Colleges and Attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2024.

a. **NABH** accreditation certificate is under process, which is required as per sub-regulation A (3) of Second Schedule of National Commission for Homoeopathy (Minimum Essential Standards for Homoeopathic Colleges and Attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2024.

b. Hospital staff:

- i. There is deficiency of one pathologist as required under sub-regulation C (1G) of Second Schedule and sub-regulation C (5) of Third Schedule of the National Commission for Homoeopathy (Minimum Essential Standards for Homoeopathic Colleges and Attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
- ii. There is deficiency of two nursing staff as required under sub-regulation C (1S) of Second Schedule and sub-regulation C (16) of Third Schedule of the National Commission for Homoeopathy (Minimum Essential Standards for Homoeopathic Colleges and Attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
- iii. There is deficiency of one operation theatre nurse as required under sub-regulation C (1T) of Second Schedule of the National Commission for Homoeopathy (Minimum Essential Standards for Homoeopathic Colleges and Attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
- iv. There is deficiency of one dietician as required under sub-regulation C (1ZA) of Second Schedule and sub-regulation C (13) of Third Schedule of the National Commission for Homoeopathy (Minimum Essential Standards for Homoeopathic Colleges and Attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2024.

The above deficiencies in hospital functioning will inevitably compromise the standards of clinical teaching and severely affect the clinical competence of medical students.

C. Salary: The salary of teaching staff, non-teaching staff, and hospital staff is not in accordance with sub-regulation E (5) of the First Schedule of the National Commission for Homoeopathy (Minimum Essential Standards for Homoeopathic Colleges and Attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2024.

2. Considering the above observations during inspection and hearing, MARBH has decided to issue permission to **Dakshin Kesari Muni Mishrilalji Homoeopathic Medical College, Behind Bibi Ka Makbara, Shree Guru Ganesh Nagar, Aurangabad – 431004**, for admission in BHMS course with intake capacity of 80 seats (reduced from 100 seats) and M.D. (Hom.) course with intake capacity of 27 seats (reduced from 42 seats) in 07 subjects namely, 06 seats in Materia Medica, 01 seat (reduced from 06 seats) in Repertory, 03 seats (reduced from 06 seats) in Organon of Medicine, 05 seats (reduced from 06 seats) in Practice of Medicine, 04 seats (reduced from 06 seats) in Pediatrics, 04 seats (reduced from 06 seats) in Psychiatry and 04 seats (reduced from 06 seats) in Pharmacy for the academic year 2026-27 as per regulation 8 of National Commission for Homoeopathy (Assessment and Rating of Medical Institutions) Regulations, 2024, for the academic year 2026-27.
3. All admissions shall be made from NEET/ AIAPGET qualified candidates only. It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats and post graduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of UG and PG seats shall be treated as All India Quota. Counselling for seats under all India quotas shall be conducted by respective Counselling Authority of State/UT Government as designated by Central Government and counselling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counselling authority of the State/UT Government.
4. The Category wise list of the selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET/AIAPGET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.
5. If the College is aggrieved by any decision of the Autonomous Board, college may prefer an appeal to the Commission against such decision within 30 days of the communication of such decision as per National Commission for Homoeopathy (Assessment and Rating of Medical Institutions) Regulations 2024, section 14 subsection (1)'. The Manner of Instructions for appeal are attached.
