Sub: Application for letter of permission for functioning of Dakshin Kesari Muni Mishrilalji Homoeopathic Medical College, Behind Bibi Ka Makbara, Shree Guru Ganesh Nagar, Aurangabad- 431004 for Admission in BHMS Undergraduate Course with Intake Capacity of 100 seats and for Post Graduate Course (MD) with intake capacity of total 42 seats in 07 subjects namely 06 seats in Homoeopathic Pharmacy, 06 seats Organon of Medicine, 06 seats in Repertory, 06 seats in Homoeopathic Materia Medica, 06 seats in Practice of Medicine, 06 seats in Paediatrics and 06 seats in Psychiatry for academic year 2025-26 – reg.

Sir/Madam,

Dakshin Kesari Muni Mishrilalji Homoeopathic Medical College, Behind Bibi Ka Makbara, Shree Guru Ganesh Nagar, Aurangabad- 431004 has submitted an application for permission for sanction of 100 seats in BHMS course and for Post Graduate Course (MD) with intake capacity of total 42 seats in 07 subjects namely 06 seats in Homoeopathic Pharmacy, 06 seats Organon of Medicine, 06 seats in Repertory, 06 seats in Homoeopathic Materia Medica, 06 seats in Practice of Medicine, 06 seats in Paediatrics and 06 seats in Psychiatry for academic year 2025-26. The College has submitted the Part I information in which the entire functional profile has been narrated. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARBH) has conducted Inspection on 24.02.2025 and 25.02.2025, followed by hearing on 15.05.2025. MARBH has examined the profile of the College as to whether the college fulfils the Minimum Essential Standards 2024 as per the prevailing regulations under clauses 26 and 28 of the NCH Act 2020. On careful examination of the report, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board observed the following shortfalls:-

1. Teaching Faculty:

- i. One Associate Professor is not available in Department of Human Anatomy.
- ii. One Associate Professor & One Assistant Professor are not available in Department of Human Physiology.
- iii. One Associate Professor is not available in Department of Organon of Medicine.
- iv. One Associate Professor is not available in Department of Pathology & Microbiology.
- v. One Professor is not available in Department of Community Medicine.
- vi. Dr. Shalini Ankushe is Principal of the college and Professor in Department of Materia Medica.
- vii. One Associate Professor & One Assistant Professor are not available in Department of Pharmacy for PG.

- viii. One Assistant Professor is not available in Department of Repertory for PG.
- ix. One Assistant Professor is not available in Department of Practice of Medicine for PG.

As evident from the above statement, a total number of 07 UG teachers are deficient against the requirement of 40 + 1 for 100 seats UG college (As specified in MES, 2024). Pursuant to F.No. :3-2/MARBH/NCH/2025-26/162-169 dtd. 16/04/2025 issued by MARBH, a college can avail 10% relaxation against the required number of teachers for Academic Year 2025-26 only. After allowing relaxation of 10%, college still has deficiency of 03 teacher. However, such relaxed number of teachers may be appointed at the earliest for smooth conduct of course.

There is also deficiency of one Assistant Professor in Postgraduate Department of Pharmacy, one Associate Professor in Postgraduate Department of Pharmacy, one Assistant Professor in Postgraduate Department of Repertory and one Assistant Professor in Postgraduate Department of Practice of Medicine.

2. Miscellaneous:


- i. NABH registered on entry level.
 - ii. NABL accreditation for laboratory is not available.
 - iii. Pay scale of all the teaching staff is not according to MES- 2024.
 - iv. Details of practicing consultant as visiting faculty of Modern Medicine or Homoeopathy are not available.
3. Considering the above observations during inspection, MARBH has decided to issue **Conditional permission to Dakshin Kesari Muni Mishrilalji Homoeopathic Medical College, Behind Bibi Ka Makbara, Shree Guru Ganesh Nagar, Aurangabad- 431004 for continuing UG (BHMS) course with intake capacity of 100 seats for academic year 2025-26.**
 4. MARBH has decided to give permission to the college for PG course with 37 seats (reduced from 42), namely **Organon of Medicine and Homoeopathic Philosophy with 06 seats, Homoeopathic Materia Medica with 06 seats, Paediatrics with 06 seats, Psychiatry with 06 seats, Homoeopathy Pharmacy with 03 seats (reduced from 06), Homoeopathic Repertory and case taking with 05 seats (reduced from 06) and Practice of Medicine with 05 seats (reduced from 06) for academic year 2025-26.**
 5. All admissions shall be made from NEET/ AIAPGET qualified candidates only. It is further informed that minimum 15% of seats of the permitted intake capacity of BHMS course shall be treated as All India Quota. Counseling for seats under All India Quota shall be conducted by Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling authority of the state/UT designated by Central Government. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government for All India Quota or the student admitted thereunder.
 6. The Category wise list of the selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET/AIAPGET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.
 7. If the College is aggrieved by any decision of the Autonomous Board, college may prefer an appeal to the Commission against such decision within 30 days of the communication of such decision as per National Commission for Homoeopathy (Assessment and Rating of Medical Institutions)
